



A Message from KIM COOK

Over the past several weeks as I've settled into my new role as President of Bread of Life Mission, I've had the pleasure of spending time with Willie Parish Jr. How blessed the Mission has been to have such an

incredible leader at its helm for so many years! Willie grew this ministry into one of Seattle's leading providers of food, shelter, addiction recovery programs and other support services for people who are homeless and hurting. I'm both humbled and honored to follow in his footsteps as President – and **I'm excited to get to know YOU and the other generous donors who have helped make the Mission what it is today.**

Roman's childhood was spent without family – without a dad, without a mom. The memories are so painful, he can't speak about them. As he grew up, he tried to look forward, aiming his life on a positive trajectory, but the bad habits he adopted to cope took their toll. Some of his old trauma began to repeat itself as he formed his own young family.

"When my daughter was born, I was the happiest man on the planet," he recalls. During that time, he was working two jobs... and also using meth. His frightened wife finally mustered the courage to present Roman with two choices: either alcohol and drugs... or their family.

His addiction was in full force, and his group of friends at the time only made things worse. "I can't blame anybody but myself," he admits. "I just wasn't strong enough to say no." Before long, Roman was out on the street, sleeping under a bridge.

By the Lord's grace, Roman met a pastor who told him about the Mission. "Do you want to change?" was a question that hit him like a ton of bricks. "It was either now or never," he remembers.

At the Mission, Roman began to feel like things were coming together for him. Here, he not only experienced a much-needed change of environment, but he also received the support of other individuals going through similar challenges.

Through our Christ-centered classes, Roman has learned to set healthy boundaries and pray in a more personal way. "I always knew God was there, but I didn't understand how to connect with Him."

In serving in our kitchen, Roman contributes his talents toward the good cause of feeding up to 80 people three times per week, which has also built valuable skills for his future. This work brings him joy, and solidifies the new friendships he's made around the Mission.

In striving to become a good example for his daughter, Roman now takes every opportunity to make positive choices.

Roman is filled with thanksgiving for God's redeeming love in his life – and your incredible generosity and support! "My new life is filled with purpose, and I'm so happy about that!"
